4 Day Trip to Glasgow

We are delighted to offer the opportunity for a 4 day visit to Glasgow from Sunday 9th May until Wednesday 12th May. For members in the South we will be flying from Luton to Glasgow return. For Northern members the travel alternatives are flying, train or driving.

The provisional itinerary will run as follows:

Sunday 9th May 2010

Fly to Glasgow from Luton to arrive by 1pm.

PM - Pollok House and Pollok Park with tea in the original kitchens.
Eve - Dinner with entertainer at Glasgow New Synagogue.

Monday 10th May 2010

AM - Trip to Loch Lomond with lunch.
PM – Burrell Collection – collection of over 9000 works of art.
Eve – Dinner at L'Chaims Kosher Restaurant.

Tuesday 11th May 2010

AM – Garnethill Synagogue and Jewish Archives. Tour of the Gorbals where the Jewish people settled on their arrival in Glasgow
PM – Kelvingrove Art Gallery and Museum Holocaust Section
Eve – Musical – *Laughter in the Rain* featuring the music of Neil Sedaka at The Kings Theatre.

Wednesday 12th May 2010

AM – Giffnock Synagogue and the Queens Park Synagogue Stained Glass Windows by John Clark.

Lunch at the Café at *House for an Art Lover*. Designed by Charles Rennie Mackintosh in 1901.

The estimated cost is £400 (depending on mode of travel), 3 night's hotel stay and all of the above visits and transport by coach.
